

The Public is Invited to Attend an Open House for the Milford Solar Phase II Project

For a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to construct and operate the Milford Solar Phase II Project (Project). The CUP application was amended on April 15, 2020, and on July 21, 2020, the Beaver County Commission approved the application and issued CUP No. 2019-07. The approval of the CUP was based in part on the May 2020 Environmental Assessment Report (EAR) prepared by SWCA Environmental Consultants at the direction of the County. Milford Solar II has submitted an application to amend CUP No. 2019-07 to exclude a portion of the lands initially approved for use by the Project; include new lands to be added to the CUP and the Project area; and increase the generation capacity of the Project from approximately 250 megawatts (MW) to 300 MW.

Members of the public and all interested parties are invited to attend an open house on September 14, 2023, at the Milford City Administrative Building Multi-Purpose room from 5 – 7 pm MT. This meeting is to give the public an opportunity to provide input on the proposed Project and amendments and present any issues or concerns.

The Planning Commission has requested that Milford prepare a supplement to the EAR so that it includes the impacts that would occur from the Project changes that would be authorized by proposed CUP amendment. Following the open house, the Supplemented EAR will be made available for review by the public and the County for 30 days.
